



MEETING MINUTES

- A. CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor James Mitchell called the meeting to order, and the pledge of allegiance was recited. The meeting started at 1:10 pm.
- B. ROLL CALL:** Present were Mayor James Mitchell, Alderman Steve Vogt, Alderwoman Barb Howarth, and Alderwoman Jeanette Struempf. Alderman Kevin Guffey was not present but participated virtually. Also present were City Treasurer Charro Reasor, City Clerk Sherree Burkholder
- C. ADDITIONS TO AND APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Discussion concerning the SIP Grant.
- D. NEW BUSINESS:**
Discuss the need to apply for another Wastewater Grant.
Jeff Medows was present to express his concerns about the recent grant not being adequate to cover both the treatment and the collection facility's needs. However, after discussion with MoDNR, Jeff was advised not to move forward with the treatment facility grant at this time. He also addressed the council about the progress of the SIP grant. He believes the funding for both grants (the initial collection grant and the SIP Grant) would be just days away. Taking Jeff's advice, there was no need for the council to vote at this time.
